

BE SURE TO PACK

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- 3 Sets of camouflage hunting clothing. Please be reminded that daily laundry service is available.
 - Day wear: Light weight cotton clothing is sufficient. (Neutral colors while on Safari and dark colors/camouflage while inside the blinds).
 - Cotton bush jacket with pockets
 - Comfortable walking shoes or lightweight safari boots, tennis shoes or desert boots. You may encounter burrs so may want to choose a soft soled shoe that can be worn without socks.
 - Extra pair of lightweight shoes (to wear at day's end).
 - Wool sweater or jacket and a lightweight rain coat.
 - Swim Suit (Bushmen offers a picturesque swimming pool)
 - Binoculars
 - Rangefinder
 - Camera, HD video camera with small tripod
 - Compound Bow with lighted pins (in case of bad light)
 - 2 dozen arrows with good broadheads
 - Face mask or camouflage paint and camouflage glove for shooting hand
 - Small flashlight
 - 6 practice arrows (exactly like the hunting arrows)
 - Sunglasses (A GOOD pair and a spare)
 - One or two billed hats and a winter hat for the mornings and nights.
 - Sunscreen, insect repellent lotion (musk oil) or scent-free repellent
 - Scent-free personal toiletries (soap, shampoo, and deodorant), etc. (No cologne perfume in the blinds).
 - Daypack or small bag (carry items to/from blind)
 - Reading material (when patience is required). E-Readers need to have non-back lit capability.
 - Passport (Leave a color copy of your passport with family or friends)
 - Airline Tickets (Leave a copy of your itinerary/tickets with family or friends)
 - Map of South Africa and a map of Bushmen Safaris (We can provide a map for first timers)
 - Electrical currency adapter kit (Radio Shack carries inexpensive kits), chargers, any needed USB cords.
 - Spare batteries and memory cards.
 - Keys and locks (to lock your bow case, should you store any valuables)
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
